In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), all employees are recommended to be immunized against influenza.

Many of our patients are considered high-risk for influenza-related complications, which can result in death. In addition, health care workers are at increased risk for getting influenza due to their exposure from patients and in the community.

Immunization is the best way to prevent influenza and avoid spreading it to others, including patients, co-workers and loved ones, who may be at high risk for influenza-related complications.

About Influenza

Each year, over 200,000 Americans are hospitalized and over 36,000 die from influenza and influenza-related complications. In fact, influenza – a vaccine-preventable disease – is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States.
